

FEPO Meeting August 20, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 by Monty.

Lisa read the minutes from the May meeting. Monty made a motion to approve, Rene seconded the motion.

Rene read the treasurers' report from May, also stated that it is on the district website.

Rene then read the treasurers' report for July 18 – August 20. Then she explained last years budget. Monty made a motion to approve it was seconded by Tami.

Larry Gawith gave the Administrators' report. School was off to a good start and they would begin MAP testing soon.

Patty Baker gave a site council report and a general overview of what the site council does. They had been looking into how to get white boards for the class rooms last year. They had hoped to get a grant but it did not come through. So they were still researching the problem.

The Garage sale made \$716.85 towards new playground equipment.

Looking into having the HS students build the equipment, then FEPO would only need to have the cost of the materials. Also, checking the possibility of the board matching funds.

This years projected budget was reviewed and approved. The Fall fundraiser was eliminated and replaced with a spring carnival.

Monty moved to accept the budget with a \$500 increase for box tops. Denise seconded the motion.

Beth Wittenberg introduced the idea of a Fall fundraiser that would include parents, students and teachers, such as a Pajama Movie Night with everything donated.

Other fundraiser ideas included a Halloween carnival, a haunted house or a Drive In fundraiser.

Beth Wittenberg discussed The Parent Wellness Committee

They are looking for committee members, She will be addressing site council also. Their goal is to improve nutrition and fitness in the district. They are looking into a fitness course, having meals and healthier choices available at the concession stands. Also would like to have students involved in meal planning and preparation. They would like to see recess before lunch so students will not rush through eating to go out and play. There is a Wellness committee but no parent or student involvement yet.
