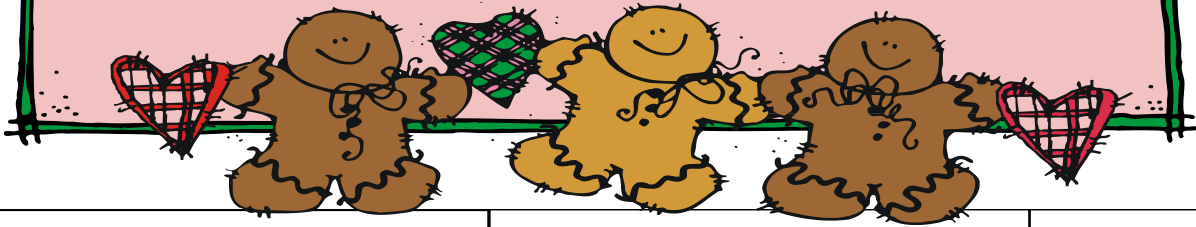


Happy Holidays!



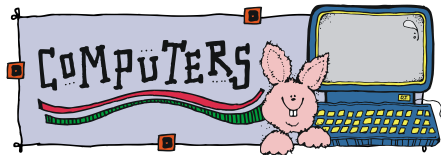
Gingerbread houses
